Duane Barker, 80, of Keosauqua, Iowa passed away on August 26, 2020 at Van Buren County Hospital in Keosauqua, Iowa. He was born on April 26, 1940 in Keosauqua, Iowa to Arnold and Ruth Gilbert Barker. Duane lived nearly his entire life in Van Buren County and graduated from Keosauqua High School.

Duane was a longtime member and served as the Church Sexton for the Keosauqua United Methodist Church. He was proud of his perfect attendance at Sunday School. Duane worked at Boyd's Grocery in Keosauqua and was a charter member of the Keosauqua Lions Club for 45 years. He always helped others when he could, was a consistent blood donor for the American Red Cross, and an avid Van Buren County Warriors fan.

He is survived by his brother, Norman Barker of Keosauqua; and many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Arnold Barker and Ruth Gilbert Jones; and stepmom, Ruth Barker; a brother, Donald Barker; and three nephews, Ryne Barker, Steve Barker, and Brett Barker.
